2010 Pool Rules



Verdict Ridge

These rules and regulations are for the enjoyment of club members and their approved guests and may be modified by VRCC at any time.

1. Pool Manager and lifeguards are employed to enforce all rules and regulations.
2. Access to the pool facility is allowed only when the lifeguard is on duty.
3. All members and their approved guests must sign in with lifeguard.
4. Guest Policy: APPROVED GUESTS
Child-care providers (Nannies, Grandparents, etc.), Out of town Guests (not living within 30 miles) are free of charge. Local Guests arranged through Staff and paying appropriate fee of \$5.00 per guest (limited use).
Non-Member Residents are not considered approved guests of the pool facility, unless issued a pass by club General Manager or Membership Director.
* Any member who disregards this rule will be fined a fee of \$50 per incident and will lose member privileges for a time period decided by the club.
5. Age Guidelines:
 - A. All persons under the age of (14) fourteen must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Adults must be age (18) eighteen or older.
 - B. Individuals 14-17 years old may enter facility without a parent if they pass the lifeguard-administered swimming test and lifeguard is on duty.
6. Please shower before entering the pool.
7. Individuals with skin conditions or injuries, respiratory or other illness, infections, fever or other contagious malady are not allowed in pool.
8. Proper swim attire is required in the pool. (Cutoffs are not permitted)
9. No running, diving or roughness will be allowed.
10. "Adult Only" swim will take place during the last 10 minutes of each hour. The lifeguard will determine enforcement and utilization depending on pool attendance. Children under the age of three may be in the pool with their parents during adult swim time w/ appropriate swim diapers.
11. Infants and toddlers are required to wear swim diapers
 - A. No diaper changing is permitted in the pool area.
 - B. Children with diarrhea are not permitted in the pool under any circumstances. (NC State Statute)
12. Members and guests are asked to refrain from conversations with the lifeguard while they are on duty monitoring the pool.



13. There are to be NO exposed alcoholic beverages or abusive/ objectionable language at the pool. All beer cans must be in a "hugger" or poured into a plastic container.

14. Toys and inflatable items may be used at the discretion of the lifeguard.

Regular Pool Hours

Monday- Saturday 10 am to 8 PM

12 PM to 6 PM Sunday

Labor Day & Memorial Day 10 am to 8 PM

15. Members and their guests agree to follow all rules and neither the pool management company, lifeguards or Verdict Ridge Golf & Country Club are responsible for injuries to members or their guests while using the pool or recreational facility. Members are responsible for their guests and family members for all costs resulting from damages due to negligence or abuse.

16. Party Guidelines: (All pool party bookings must submit Booking Contract prior to event)

A. Pool Parties of 20 people or less- management must be notified seven days in advance and authorization must be given. Members must also pay the appropriate \$5 non-member guest fee per guest.

B. Pool Parties of 21 or more people- will require the pool facility to be closed to normal member use. 30 day written notice must be given.

One- three Hour private events (\$150)

Three or more hour private events (\$250)

C. For all after hour parties please call 704-257-0113 for additional fees and requirements.

D. Verdict Ridge require that guards from Aqua tech, INC. be used for all special functions after normal business hours or large day time events. The cost of the guards shall be the responsibility of the member requesting the event. The current rate is \$15 per lifeguard per hour.

17. In the event of inclement weather, the pool will be closed until 30 minutes after the last rainfall/thunder/lightning.

18. The telephone at the pool is for emergency purposes only. Pool number 704-483-9292

19. All Federal / State/ Local laws apply.

SLIDE RULES

Riders ride at their own risk and parents are responsible for the safety of their children.

- Upon exiting from the slide, swimmers must move out of the splash area immediately
- Maximum operational load: 1 person up to 250 pounds
- Human chains are strictly forbidden
- Riders may not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide
- Caution: For safety reasons, pregnant women and persons with heart conditions or back trouble cannot ride this slide
- No swimming or flotation devices are allowed in the slide
- Riders must go down the slide feet first, lying on their back
- No standing, kneeling, rotating or stopping in the slide
- Riders must be 36 inches tall to use the slide, 48 inches unaccompanied by adult.
- Parents/Guardians may catch their own "struggling" swimmers at the bottom, but MUST clear the area immediately. No rider may continue till the area is cleared
- No running or horseplay on the stairs, landings or waterslides is allowed
- Do not use the slide while under the influence of alcohol or other drugs

Consequences: Failure to follow the above rules will result in loss of pool access for a portion or all of the remaining season at the discretion of club management.
